Context


Our dental clinics has provided 1,961 dental service in the month of May 2019, the deterioration of security situation is negatively impacting our ability to reach our clinics. And the overall number of patients is dropping to a warring point where we believe that many are ignoring dental pain because unable to access the centers. Awareness sessions has been provided to only 16 children, because it was very difficult to address preventive issues in the middle of a massive displacement, where shelter and food security are prioritized for most of the families.


Treatment profile
