Context


Our dental clinics have provided a total of 1937 free dental services in the month of August 2019, while the whole region is witnessing a difficult security situation and an escalation in military operations that led to the displacement of a large number of population and many civilian casualties.

Awareness sessions were provided to 50 children, through community health workers in the camps, children learnt about the appropriate methods of preventing tooth decays and maintaining their oral health.


