

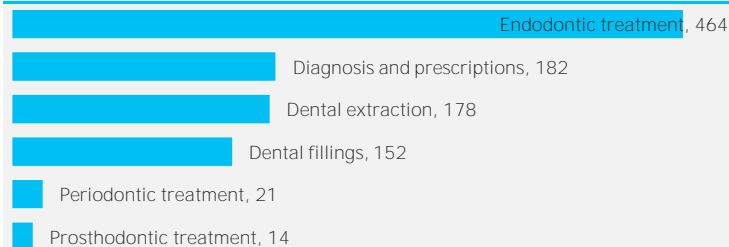
Context

Our dental clinics provided a total of 1011 free dental services in November 2019, this is the lowest rate that we had in last two years, this is occurring while aerial bombardment is increasing in southern Idlib and in northern Hama, in addition to eastern Lattakia and northern Aleppo, 4 health centers have been targeted during the last period, which has greatly affected peoples' willing to access health centers.

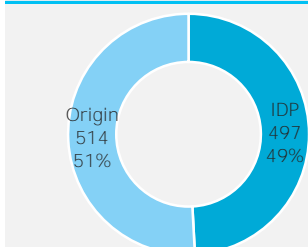
Awareness sessions were provided to 30 children, through community health workers in northern displacement camps, they have instructed on the appropriate ways to prevent tooth decays and maintain oral health.

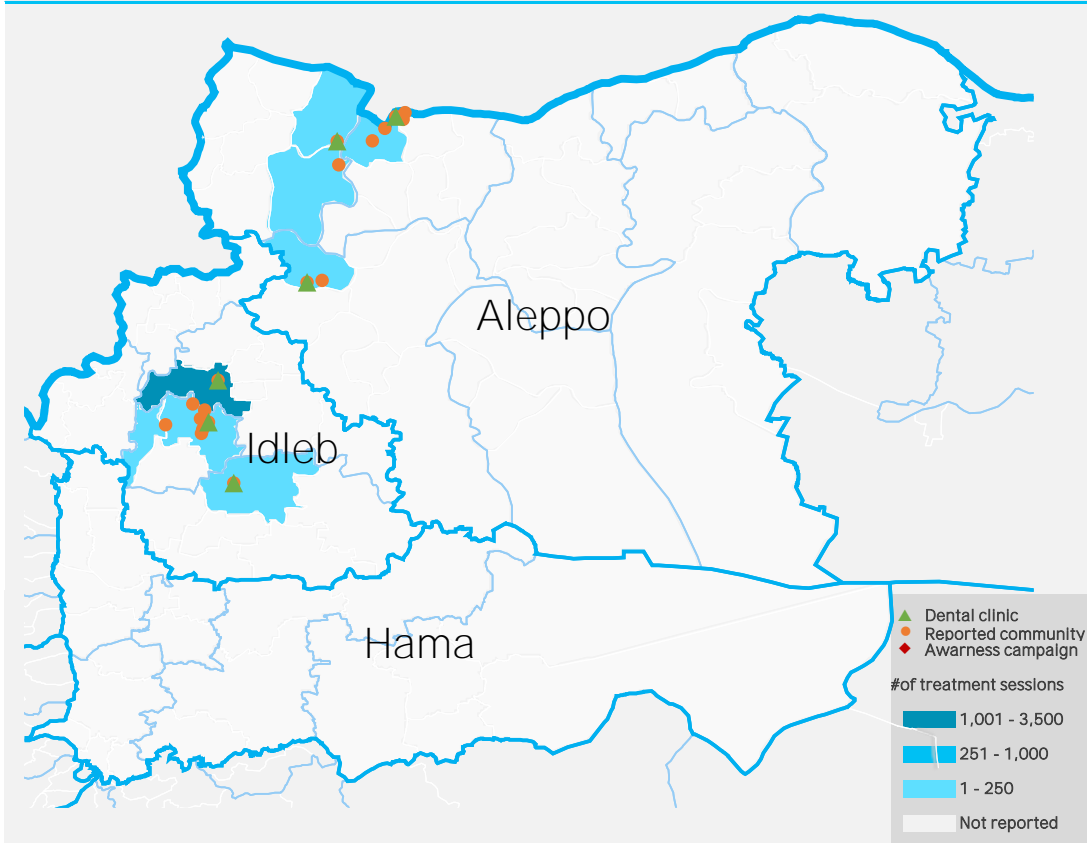
